
Unlink Client Organization

As a Provider, you may need to remove your Provider-client relationship with an organization if you are no longer providing services to them. In order for a client organization to be eligible for removal:

- You must be a [Provider admin](#).
- The client organization must have at least one [confirmed owner](#).

Once these criteria are met:

1. Open the Provider Portal using the product switcher:
