# Mappar

### Mappar

Mappar är strukturer som används för att organisera ditt individuella valv genom att samla inloggningar, kort, identiteter och säkra anteckningar. Att använda mappar är ett bra sätt att göra dina valvobjekt lätta att hitta. Alla valvobjekt kan läggas till i en mapp, inklusive objekt som delas med dig från en organisation.

#### **⊘** Tip

Items added to a folder will still appear in your vault when **All vaults** is selected from the filter menu, and deleting a folder **will not** delete the items in that folder. Deleting a folder is permanent, and the folder cannot be recovered once deleted.

#### ⇒Web vault

To create a folder, select the  $\mathbf{New} \lor$  button and choose **Folder** from the dropdown:

Once created, you can rename or delete a folder at any time using the hover-over  $\mathscr{P}$  Pencil icon:



#### ⇒Mobile

Edit or Delete a Folder

To create a folder, tap the <sup>®</sup> Settings menu, tap the Vault option, and tap the Folders option. Tap the + Add icon to add a folder. Once created, you can rename a folder from the same menu by tapping the folder, or delete the folder using the : menu:

### ⇒CLI

Folders on mobile

To create a folder, use the command:

#### Bash

bw create folder <foldername>

You can edit an existing folder using by edit <folderId> and delete one using by delete folder <folderId>. For more information, please refer the the Bitwarden CLI documentation.

#### (i) Note

If you are a member of an organization, collections will be shown below your folders in the Filters menu.

There are similarities between folders and collections. **Folders organize your individual vault** (but can include shared items) and are unique to you, where collections are shared between members of organizations.

#### Kapslade mappar

Mappar kan "kapslas" för att logiskt organisera dem i ditt valv. Det finns ingen gräns för djupet med vilket du kan kapsla mappar, men att skapa för många nivåer kan störa ditt valvs gränssnitt.

#### (i) Note

Searching inside a "parent" folder will not include items in folders nested inside it as potential search results. For more information, see search your vault.



Nested folders

För att skapa en kapslad mapp, ge en ny mapp ett namn som innehåller "förälder"-mappen följt av ett snedstreck (/) avgränsare, till exempel Socials/Forum. Du kan också byta namn på befintliga mappar på samma sätt för att kapsla dem under andra befintliga mappar.

Om det inte finns någon mapp med motsvarande "förälder"-namn, kapslar mappen inte och dess titel visas i sin helhet.

### Flytta objekt till en mapp

När du har skapat en mapp i ditt valv finns det några sätt att flytta objekt till den:

#### ⇒Web vault

From the web vault, you can either:

• Navigate to the Add item or Edit item screen, select your new folder from the Folder dropdown and Save your item:

### ⇒CLI

Move item to a folder on mobile

Use the **bw** edit command to manipulate the **folderId** attribute of the vault item JSON object, as in the following example:

#### Bash

bw get item 7ac9cae8-5067-4faf-b6ab-acfd00e2c328 <Markdown id="7j5zoKrVKfAeuwXSrKN6Y3" /> bw edit item 7ac9cae8-5067-4faf-b6ab-acfd00e2c328

#### **⊘** Tip

Using edit will require you to:

- Use the get command with the exact id of the item you want to edit.
- Know the exact **folderId** of the folder you want to move it to.
- Manipulate the JSON object (specifically, the **folderId** attribute) with a command-line JSON processor like jq.
- Use the encode command to encode changes to the JSON object.

If you are unfamiliar with using any of these parts, please refer to the Bitwarden CLI documentation.

#### **∂** Tip

Items shared with you from an organization can be added to your folders, and doing so will only impact how the item appears in your individual vault (for example adding an item to a folder won't give anyone access to that folder, or change whether it's in a folder in their individual vaults).
